VCP Outcome Area - Improve cancer outcomes

Grampians results:



Highest rate of metastatic solid cancers at diagnosis in Victoria = Late Diagnosis in the Grampians



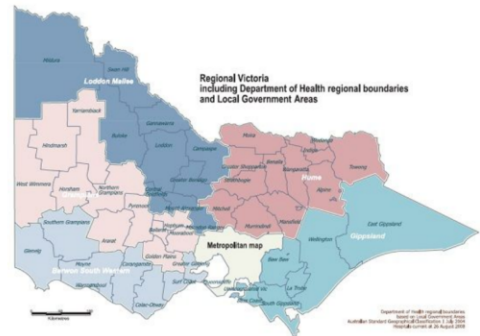
2 of the highest LGAs in the state for preventable cancers
! Horsham and Hindmarsh
 But Grampians has the lowest incidence (Regional ICS) for this indicator overall



Highest regional ICS for lifetime risk of cancer before 85 years of age and highest in Vic for Colorectal ca incidence
! (Hindmarsh highest LGA in Victoria for colorectal incidence)



! Consistently second highest ICS for premature death rates from all cancers (2010-13, 2014-17)
! Hindmarsh highest death rate due to cancer (of all LGAs in Victoria)



VCP Outcome Area - Optimal diagnostics and treatment

Grampians results:



Median Days from Diagnosis to first curative Treatment:
!! Colorectal cancer - 27 days (second longest of all ICS)
 ✓ Haematological cancer - 16 days (best ICS)



GICS Lowest all-cancer rate for radical radiotherapy
11.9% vs 23.3% state



GICS all-cancer timeliness to Chemotherapy as first treatment
 2014 - 45.7% 2015 - 43.7% 2016 - **31.1%**
Colorectal only
 2014 - 50% 2015 - 25% 2016 - **9.5%**



% patients receiving **specialist palliative care** within 12 months prior to death

83% vs 77% statewide

% **deaths** due to cancer that occur in hospitals

76% vs 71% statewide
